Cycle 3, Week 6- White House (final drawing) Age 10-11

Materials:

- White House print-outs
- Pencils
- Rulers
- Photograph of the White House
- Colored pencils

Reminder: Use OiLs terminology as you give directions and help students

- 1. Students complete mirror-image of White House.
- 2. Add an element of their choosing using one-point perspective. Examples could include trees, bushes, path, etc.
- 3. Add an American flag on the pole above the center of the White House.
- 4. Show a photograph of the White House. Students can study it and add details to the outdoor scene or the building.
- 4. Students color in their artwork. Encourage them to use shading as they color in the scene.
