## Cycle 3, Week 6- White House (final drawing) Age 7-9

## Materials:

- White House print-outs
- Pencils
- Rulers
- Photograph of the White House
- Colored pencils

**Reminder:** Use OiLs terminology as you give directions and help students

- 1. Students complete mirror-image of White House. You can do this step-by-step as a class, or let students work on it independently as you walk around and help individuals.
- 2. Add two to three trees using one-point perspective.
- 3. Add an American flag on the pole above the center of the White House.
- 4. Show students how to color in one tree using shading. Have them follow along on their drawing.
- 5. Show a photograph of the White House. Students can study it and add details to the outdoor scene or the building if they wish.
- 5. Students color in their artwork. Encourage them to use shading as they color the trees.
